Check in anytime on Friday Afternoon in Fairfield Hall. Things get underway Friday evening at 6:30 pm. You and all the other guests are here for the week-end to invest in a new casino to be built at Allenberry by Red Diamond and a cast of Vegas characters. At the Gala Hors d'oeuvres Reception you will meet them, their energetic agent and some unexpected visitors as well. It will be apparent who the players are. Some make grand entrances. Others may be seated right next to you. Some make early and permanent exits.

Following the Reception there is an eight-course dinner served with complimentary wine. Of course, the mystery continues right through dinner. There will be plenty of clues mixed in with comedy and music throughout and following dinner.

Saturday Breakfast, complete with Allenberry's world-class sticky buns, begins at 8:00 am, and the mystery continues.

Dress is comfortable-casual during the day with most guests dressing for the evening reception and dinner parties. You will receive specific word about the completely optional dress theme for the Saturday night reception. Because our property consists of several separate lodges and restaurant buildings,

be prepared for short treks outdoors. You might be wise to bring boots.
